

# Visits for Adult and Community Groups

The Yale University Art Gallery offers free, hour-long guided tours to engage adult and community groups with its encyclopedic collection. Led by Gallery teaching staff, these tours provide visitors with a range of ways to look at, interact with, and enjoy works of art. Groups are also welcome to plan a self-guided visit, based on availability. All groups must register at least three weeks in advance of the visit.

## Guided Tours

- Guided tours focus on four to six works of art from across curatorial departments. The experience is discussion-based and encourages visitors to look closely, ask questions, and talk about what they see.
- Groups must be subdivided into smaller groups of 10–15 people within the galleries. Reservations for guided tours are available October through August, Tuesday through Sunday, at 12:30 pm, 1:30 pm, 2:30 pm, and 3:30 pm. Reservations must be made three weeks in advance of the visit. Acceptance of your reservation request is based on availability.
- There are no fees for guided group visits. Please bring a copy of your confirmation letter on the day of your visit.

## Self-Guided Tours

- If your group prefers to visit the Gallery without a guided tour from our teaching staff, you may schedule a self-guided visit. Scheduling your visit helps us ensure that the galleries and collection areas that you want to see will be available to you at the time of your visit. Self-guided visits may be scheduled Tuesday through Sunday, at 12:30 pm, 1:30 pm, 2:30 pm, and 3:30 pm. Groups must be subdivided into smaller groups of 10–15 people within the galleries. All groups of 10 or more people must register at least three weeks in advance of the visit. Acceptance of your reservation request is based on availability.
